

Project Guidelines

I- Display board

- 1. Use the standard A0 dimensions: 84.1 cm x 118.9 cm.
- Use font faces and colored backgrounds to associate groups of information throughout your display. Remember that black or dark type is easiest to read and that judges do notice spelling and grammar. (Please use dark colors for the text and review spelling and grammar).
- 3. Your title should be big, easy to read, and capture the spirit of your research. You may use two titles if you wish: a scientific targeted one on top and one for the lay audience below it.
- 4. "A picture is worth a thousand words". Photographs and drawings are good display tools: they help your audience understand your research and are eye-catching aids for your display.
- 5. Label the units of measurement used on each chart axis (e.g., "Centimeters of Rain", "Years", "Number of Ladybugs"). Use metric units (SI) and scientific names, if whenever possible.
- 6. Always caption your graphs and charts and indicate trends, conclusions drawn, etc.

II- Project Model

- 1. The project model is the most important part of your project.
- 2. No specific obligations are required for the project model.

Remember that "For a Sustainable Lebanon" is the slogan!
