OBJECTIVES

The PhD in Cinema trains researchers capable of contributing in a significant and original way to the advancement of film studies and knowledge of the performing arts.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- A copy of diplomas and grades transcripts (Bachelor and Master in related fields)
- A dissertation proposal (15-20 pages)
- A copy of the M.A. research paper
- A letter of motivation

The proposal is submitted for review to two or three instructors. If accepted by a potential supervisor, it is then submitted to the Doctoral School of Human and Social Sciences (EDSHS).
