

TITLE-BASED ADMISSION

First Ranks in the Baccalaureate

Candidates who ranked first, second and third in Lebanon, whether in the French or the Lebanese 2025 Baccalaureate may enroll at the institution of their choice, provided that their Baccalaureate track aligns with the program they are applying to. They must confirm their choice and submit a certified copy of their diploma along with the grade certificate within ten days of the official publication of the French or Lebanese Baccalaureate results.

Baccalaureate Average 18.5/20

Candidates who have obtained an overall average of 18.5/20 or higher in the first session of the French or Lebanese 2025 Baccalaureate may enroll at the institution of their choice, except for the Faculty of Medicine, under two conditions: their baccalaureate track matches the requirements of the chosen institution, and they applied for admission during either the early or the regular admission period. They must confirm their choice and submit a certified copy of their diploma along with the grade certificate within ten days of the official publication of the French or Lebanese Baccalaureate results.

Baccalaureate Average 17/20

Candidates who have obtained an overall average of 17/20 or higher in the first session of the French or Lebanese 2025 Baccalaureate may enroll at the institution of their choice, except for the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Dental Medicine, under two conditions: their baccalaureate track matches the requirements of the chosen institution, and they applied for admission during either the early or the regular admission period. They must confirm their choice and submit a certified copy of their diploma along with the grade certificate within ten days of the official publication of the French or Lebanese Baccalaureate results.
