



## ADMISSION FOR INTERNATIONAL CANDIDATES

Non-Lebanese candidates who completed their First, Second and Third Secondary years in an institution abroad may benefit from certain special provisions in the following cases: file-based selection, entrance exam-based admission during the regular period, or admission based on the overall average of the official French Baccalaureate exams. Candidates must specify in their application whether or not they have applied for Admission for International Candidates. They may also be candidates for Regular Admission.

### File-Based Selection Admission

International candidates who apply for Admission for International Candidates are allocated a quota of spots set by the institution in question.

### Entrance Exam-Based Admission

International candidates who apply for an Entrance Exam-Based Admission during the regular period are allocated a quota of spots set by the institution in question. The exam curriculum is the same as that of the Regular Admission.

### Baccalaureate Average 18.5/20

Candidates who have obtained an overall average of 18.5/20 or higher in the French 2025 Baccalaureate may enroll at the institution of their choice under one condition: that the baccalaureate track matches the requirements of the chosen institution. They must confirm their choice and submit a certified copy of the diploma with the grade certificate by Thursday, August 14, 2025.

### Baccalaureate Average 17/20

Candidates who have obtained an overall average of 17/20 or higher in the French 2024 Baccalaureate may enroll at the institution of their choice, except for the Faculty of Medicine and the Faculty of Dental Medicine, under one condition: that the baccalaureate track matches the requirements of the chosen institution. They must confirm their choice and submit a certified copy of the diploma with the grade certificate by Thursday, August 14, 2025.

### Special Provisions for Lebanese Candidates Living Abroad

For Lebanese candidates who have completed all their secondary education in an institution abroad and who have applied to a program where the selection method is based on a file study, an adjustment factor for their school will be calculated so as not to disadvantage them over candidates applying from well-known schools at the University.
