

PROVISIONS OF THE JOINT SELECTION BOARDS

Candidates who have applied to two or more programs within the same Joint Selection Board and who have been admitted to one of them may request, within 30 days of results' publication, to switch to a lower priority choice. If their weighted average allows it, they may then obtain a new admission that would replace the old one, since they can only retain one admission within a joint selection board.

N.B.: The provisions of the joint selection board only apply to the early and regular admission periods.
