- Coordinating research efforts, valorization, and scientific exchanges among instructors and researchers across campuses, working within centers, laboratories, and chairs.
- Establishing and promoting research and advanced training programs that meet the highest scientific and academic standards, serving the needs of the University, Lebanon, and the broader region.
- Establishing national recognition for laboratories as reference institutions for public authorities and private entities, while also striving for international reach.
- Building and strengthening connections with industrial research and socio-economic sectors through technology transfer tailored to community needs.
- Fostering the development of doctoral schools and high-level PhD training within these schools.
- Rigorously upholding ethical research policies and standards under the guidance of the University's Ethics Committee.
