

CHAIR OF “FONDATION DIANE” IN EDUCATION FOR ECO-CITIZENSHIP AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (CEEDD)

The Chair of “Fondation Diane” in Education for Eco-Citizenship and Sustainable Development was established at the Saint Joseph University of Beirut in September 2015 by “Fondation Diane” and its Chairholder, Mr. Fadi (EL) HAGE. Its mission is to raise awareness, educate, and produce knowledge in these fields to help achieve the 17 SDGs set by the United Nations, and to train citizens and co-responsible leaders, using 5 intervention methods:

- 2- **Raising awareness** through conferences, webinars, seminars, and contests.
- 3- **Conducting research** by organizing and participating in national and international scientific symposia, managing research projects, supervising internships and dissertations, and awarding PhD scholarships.
- 4- **Managing projects** in environmental and civic fields such as water, energy, waste management, biodiversity, equity, women's rights, etc.
- 5- **Building partnerships and fostering cooperation** at national and international levels.

The CEEDD Chair aims to serve as an interdisciplinary reference platform that promotes eco-citizen and education for sustainable development. It seeks to connect related initiatives at the national, regional, and international levels.
