

PRACTICAL SERVICES

Since students dedicate a considerable amount of time to their studies, they spend more time at USJ than anywhere else. As a result, the University offers practical services aimed at ensuring their stay goes as smoothly as possible.

Parking Lots

Instructors are provided with parking spaces on campuses, and must obtain an access sticker from the administration.

Some campuses offer parking spaces for students, but access conditions vary by campus.

Science and Technology Campus: free access.

Humanities Campus: paid access with a sticker obtained from the parking supervisor.

Medical Sciences Campus: paid access to the Innovation and Sports Campus, located a few hundred meters from the Campus, by subscription, available from the parking supervisor.

Innovation and Sports Campus: paid access by subscription, available from the parking supervisor.

Regional Campuses: free access.

Student Housing

Housing is provided at the University dorms, “USJ Dorms”. Students can stay there for a maximum of 3 consecutive academic years.

Catering

The Beirut and regional campuses have cafeterias open to all. They offer full, balanced meals, snacks, sandwiches, and both hot and cold drinks.

Vending Machines

Our campuses are equipped with vending machines that provide various services. Coffee machines and snack dispensers are available at CST, CSM, CSS, CSH and CIS.

Photocopiers and Printers

Paid photocopiers and printers are available to students in certain libraries and/or bookstores on the main and regional campuses.

Some institutions are also equipped with photocopiers and printers accessible to registered students through a free magnetic card.

First Aid Services at USJ

All USJ campuses are equipped with first aid services and necessary equipment to respond to emergencies that may arise on campus. A team of staff members specifically trained in first aid, supported by student paramedics, manages the following emergency response chain:

- Alerting, diagnosing the severity of the situation, and informing relevant personnel.
- Providing first aid, assisting the patient, and transferring them to the first-aid room.
- Arranging transportation to the hospital in coordination with the Red Cross, Civil Defense, or other appropriate means, depending on the case.

It should also be noted that approximately one hundred individuals across the campuses have been trained to serve as first responders and to activate the emergency response chain.
