ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Candidates must:

- Hold the Lebanese Baccalaureate or its equivalent.
- Hold a Master's degree in engineering or its equivalent.
- Ensure consistency between their Master's and PhD disciplines.
- Have a minimum average of 12/20 or equivalent in the Master's degree.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Validation of 180 ECTS credits (12 course credits and 168 credits for the preparation of a PhD dissertation).
- Maximum duration of 6 years for a full-time dissertation (8 years for part-time).
- Publication as first author in peer-reviewed indexed journals or conference proceedings of two scientific papers based on dissertation results.
- Participation in the PhD days.
- Write and submit a dissertation report.
- Positive assessment from two reviewers.
- Dissertation defense before a jury.
