This seminar is designed for PhD candidates in social work. It explores the epistemological and methodological foundations specific to qualitative research. It aims to enhance candidates' practical skills in designing and conducting scientific studies within this research framework. To achieve this, theoretical concepts are complemented by practical applications focusing on current issues in the Lebanese context such as Syrian migration and forced displacement, diversity and interculturality, human rights and citizenship, protection of children's and women's rights, etc.

Understand the epistemology of quantitative research. Deepen the fundamental concepts of quantitative research. Acquire advanced skills in quantitative methods. Get acquainted with mixed methods. Apply the principles of quantitative research methodology to the dissertation project.		
015PRTHD1	Dissertation Project: Development of the Research Problem	15 Cr.
The dissertation proposal must include the following sections: title, definition of the subject, research problem and working hypotheses, research question, literature review, chosen methodology, provisional dissertation outlines and proposed work schedule. The expected length is between 30 and 35 pages. The candidate develops their project under the guidance of their dissertation supervisor. This proposal is subject to a defense before a jury. A passing grade (14-15/20) is the minimum requirement for admission to the dissertation phase. In case of failure, the candidate is allowed to reattempt during the academic year, but cannot afford a second failure. This stage of the process involves developing the research problem, which should be validated by the dissertation supervisor.		
015PTCAD1	Dissertation Project: Development of the Analytical Framework	9 Cr.
This part of the dissertation project allows PhD candidates to develop their analytical framework based on their research problem. In addition to their individual work with their dissertation supervisors, candidates are invited to participate in a seminar for collaborative work and collective reflection.		
015PTH3D2	Dissertation Project: Development of the Research Methodology	15 Cr.
The dissertation proposal is a document of approximately fifty pages, comprising the development of the research problem, the theoretical and/or conceptual framework, and the justification of the methodology in terms of its nature, epistemological positioning, and recommended research approach targeting a clearly identified population. This initial phase of work is accompanied by a collective seminar introducing the dissertation project. It is validated		

through dual assessment by both the dissertation supervisor and the seminar coordinator. Continuation of enrollment in the second semester of the PhD program depends on this assessment. A grade of 'Fair' or C (12-13/20) is required to proceed to Dissertation Project II.

015PTFSD2

Dissertation Project: Finalization and Defense

15 Cr.

This is the final part of the dissertation project where the PhD candidate defends their project before a jury. Upon a successful defense, submission of the project to the Ethics Committee is required before proceeding to the data collection phase. Group sessions enable PhD candidates to make progress on their projects and to be introduced to the requirements and procedures for writing and publishing a scientific article in line with the requirements of the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education.
