## OBJECTIVES

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The PhD in Education program is the culmination of a professional research experience enriched by scientific contributions. It aims to promote the scientific culture of PhD candidates and to develop their abilities in conceptualization, problematization, empirical investigation, and methodological reflection. It also contributes to the dissemination of research work within the educational community, ensuring research ethics, scientific integrity, and innovation in the educational field.

## ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

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Master in Education or an equivalent degree.

### 1. Pre-admission: Revision of the academic record.

Required documents:

- Master in Education validated by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon.
- Certificate of experience in an educational field (at least 2 years).
- Transcript including research thesis grade higher than 15/20.
- Proficiency in a second foreign language.
- Preliminary dissertation proposal (2-3 pages) highlighting the relevance of the topic and aligning it with the research axes of the Laboratory of Educational Research (LRE).

### 2. Admission: Presentation of the preliminary dissertation proposal.

- Written Test
- Oral presentation in front of a jury composed of the Director of the Doctoral School and research professors from the Faculty of Education.

## PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

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- The PhD journey consists of 180 credits, spanning over a period of three years or six semesters.
- The PhD journey requires the validation of 12 credits: 6 credits from seminars held at FSEDU during doctoral days and 6 credits from the Doctoral School of Human and Social Sciences (EDSH):
- Dissertation Seminar 1 (3 Cr.) Dissertation Seminar 2 (3 Cr.) Doctoral Seminars (3 Cr.) Other Activities (3 Cr.)
- The remaining credits (168 credits) are dedicated to the drafting of the dissertation manuscript.
- The PhD candidate must present his or her dissertation project within two semesters from the date of enrollment in the PhD program.
- At the end of each semester, a progress report signed by the PhD candidate and co-signed by the dissertation director is presented to the Scientific Committee and validated by the Dean to renew enrollment.
- The PhD candidate is required to publish two articles in peer-reviewed and indexed journals before the defense.
