

Mikhail Bernatsky studied ancient Greek and Latin at Yuriy Shichalin's Museum Graeco-Latinum and graduated from the State University of Management, Moscow, and later from the SS Cyril and Methodius Institute of Post-Graduate Studies.

He has taught at the National Research University Higher School of Economics and currently works as a researcher in the Ecclesiastical Institutions Research Laboratory of the St Tikhon Orthodox Humanitarian University and as a scientific editor in the Publishing House of the Moscow Patriarchate.

His research interests embrace Byzantine and post- Byzantine theology, Greek palaeography, the reception of Thomism in Byzantium, the Greek Latin controversy, and the Metropolitanate of Kyiv in the sixteenth and seventieth centuries.
