1. SOURCE OF LIVELIHOOD

About 70% of people rely directly on agriculture as a livelihood



2. FOOD SECURITY

The main requirement of any country is food security. A stable agricultural sector ensures a nation of food security.



3. ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Economic development relies on the agricultural growth rate. Since agriculture employs many people, it contributes to economic development, improving people's standard of living, is improved.
