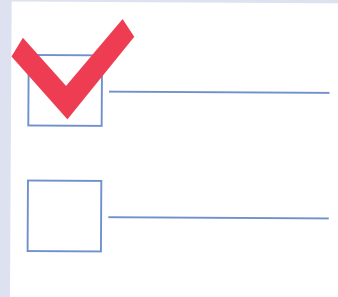
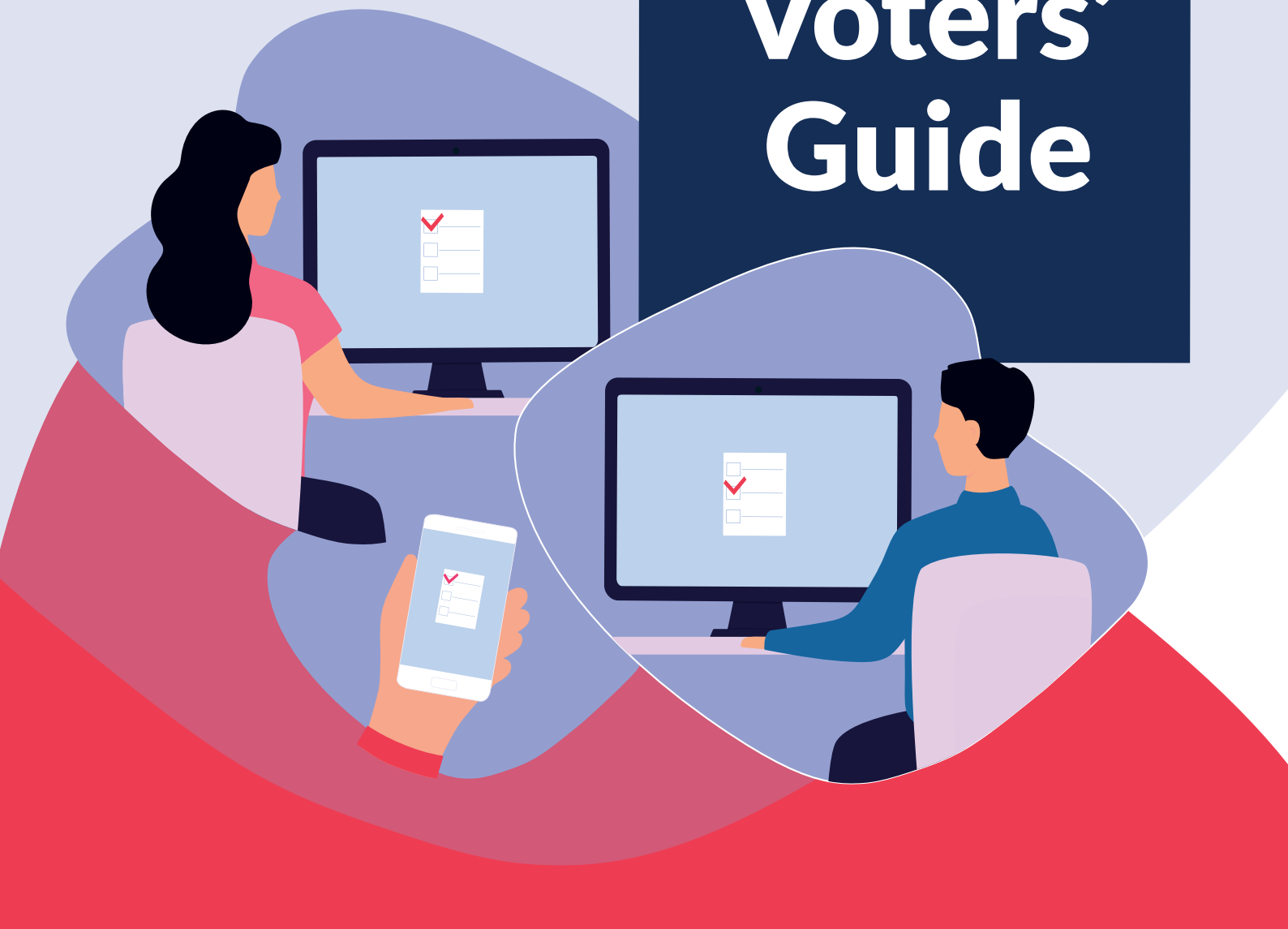

How Day of Democracy Works

As an enrolled USJ student and voter, you will receive an email on Saturday morning at 8 AM asking you to vote through a link.

Steps to vote




Step 1 Authentication

Your vote is strictly confidential.

Log in through your laptop, cell phone or tablet, making sure you have a good connection.

Sign in using your USJ email and password (if you are unsure of your password, please change it through the student portal, ideally 3 working days before the election date).

Step 2 Voting

Step 2.1: Lists of Candidates

Lists of candidates will appear on the screen providing a blank vote option.


Vote by clicking on the button that corresponds to your choice: either vote for a list or cast a blank vote.

Step 2.2: President Election

2.2.1: Should you cast a blank vote, you will not be allowed to vote for a President.


2.2.2: Should you vote for the list of your choice, you have to choose a President from the chosen list. You can also opt out of voting for a President.


