#### PROJECT TITLE:

Acquisition of a New Anesthesia Ventilator.

#### APPLICANT:

The radiology Department at Hôtel-Dieu de France, an academic medical of Saint Joseph University of Beirut, under the direction of Professor Kamal Hachem. Each year, 3,647 interventional radiology procedures are performed on patients under intervention in the vascular catheterization room.

### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:**

The interventional radiology department at HDF is a key service that performs 3647 interventional radiology procedures annually for patients requiring anesthesia, particularly in the context of vascular catheterization procedures. Currently, the available equipment no longer meets the modern technological standards required to ensure optimal care.

The acquisition of a modern anesthesia ventilator will improve patient care by providing precise and tailored ventilation while enhancing the safety of the procedures.

### ■ OBJECTIVES:

- Ensure optimal patient care in the interventional radiology room with a modern and high-performance ventilator.
- Reduce risks for patients under anesthesia during delicate procedures.
- Improve working conditions for medical teams with state-of-the-art equipment.
- Support the modernization and excellence efforts of the interventional radiology service.

#### ■ IMPACT:

The acquisition of a modern ventilator for interventiona radiology will have a major impact on the quality and safety of care at Hôtel-Dieu de France. This investment will benefit several key stakeholders:
