FONDATION USJ

Following the Beirut port blast on August 4, 2020, that has caused massive damages to USJ and its hospital, Hôtel-Dieu de France, the "USJ/HDF Emergency and Solidarity Fund" was launched to cover 4 fundraising campaigns:

Donate to Educate

In collaboration with the Fondation USJ and the Federation of USJ Alumni Associations, USJ has launched the 2020 Campaign "les uns pour les autres": Donate to Educate. The goal is to raise 2020 scholarships. The estimated goal for the campaign "Donate to Educate" is \$10,000,000 USD.

Donate to Rebuild: dedicated to the restoration of devastated campuses and faculties.

Total costs for the restoration of our 5 Campuses as well as our historic buildings (the Oriental Library, the Monnot Theater, the Museum of Prehistory, the University for All, etc.) all located within a few meters of the explosion are estimated to be, more than \$2,000,000 USD.

USJ en Mission: humanitarian project to support disadvantaged families.

More than 300,000 families have been severely affected by the explosion. This humanitarian project "USJ en mission" aimed to provide for the needs of 1000 families by sending them food boxes and hot meals and assisting them in the reconstruction works of 77 houses totally damaged that are owned by USJ students, staff and teachers. Project Estimate: **\$800,000 USD**.

Donate to Heal: in support of HDF.


Hôtel-Dieu de France, our University Hospital, which took in more than 800 wounded on the evening of the explosion, has launched its "Disaster Recovery Plan" and its teams have, as always, been on the front line since the beginning, in spite of the material damage suffered by the hospital.

Initial estimates for reconstruction work costs: \$2,000,000 USD.

HDF needs cost estimate for 2021:

- Biomedical equipment: \$4,000,000 USD.
- HDF Social Fund (Patient Support): \$2,500,000 USD.




