BASIC NEEDS: PHYSICAL & SAFETY

594 families/month supported with food boxes since March 2020

6,362 hot meals delivered to Beirut families over month after explosion

16 tons of glass debris cleaned and recycled from homes and campus

95 damaged homes assessed

53 damaged homes repaired

PSYCHOLOGICAL NEEDS: BELONGINGNESS & ESTEEM

10,000 calls made & received to check on and orient USJ members after explosion

4,200 free individual and group therapy sessions*

5,000 USJ members attended our 33 educational programs on Well-being*

250 USJ members participated in 10 well-being training programs*

300 USJ members participated in 9 teambuilding activities*

SELF-FULFILLMENT NEEDS

815 volunteers from students, staff, & faculty members

100 staff & faculty earned a coaching for well-being certificate

10 winners for inspirational speeches and videos

7 students produced a short series (103,020 reach)

21 faculty and students produced a weekly podcast (103,400 reach)
