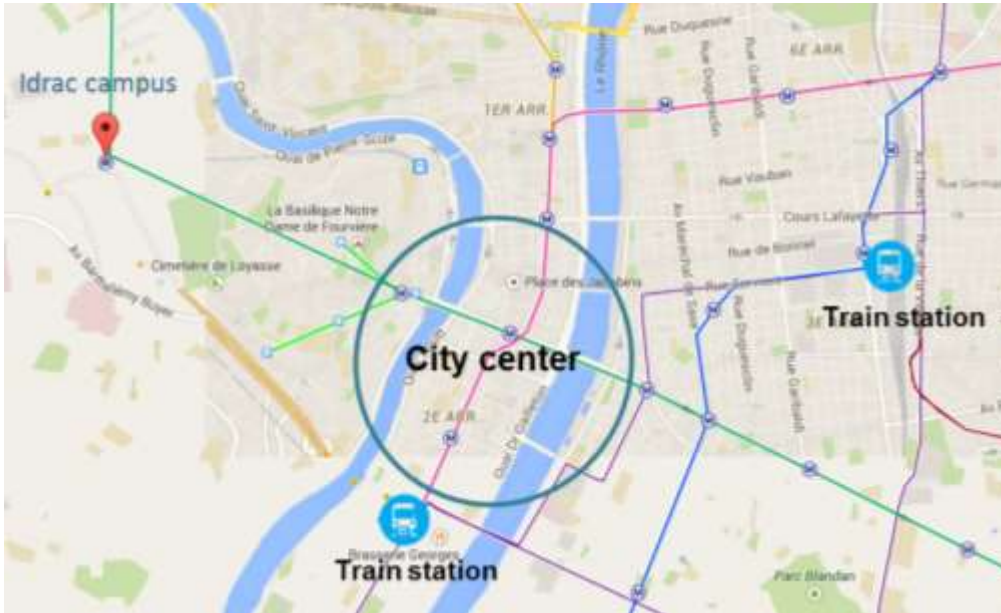


# LYON CAMPUS

# SUMMER SESSION PACKAGE

## Total price for 4 weeks (including booking fees) :

# REGISTRATION

## STEP BY STEP

---



1. Fill in the online application form **before March 31st**
2. Wait for the confirmation of enrolment
3. Go to the French Consulate and apply for a short term visa (if needed)
4. Send an mail at [studyabroad@reseau-cd.fr](mailto:studyabroad@reseau-cd.fr) as soon as you get your visa
5. Pay the package fees by bank transfer. In case of cancellation or late visa refusal (30 days or less before arrival date), booking fees (200€) will not be refunded
6. Book your train/flight and write at [studyabroad@reseau-cd.fr](mailto:studyabroad@reseau-cd.fr) to inform about your arrival date
7. Pay your accommodation deposit (200€) by bank transfer to Cardinal Campus
8. Finalize your health international insurance (compulsory upon arrival)
9. Arrive in Lyon
