MASTER IN MANAGEMENT OF ROAD SAFETY

In 2012, Saint-Joseph University of Beirut have launched the Master in Management of Road Safety. Recognized by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon, this Master is delivered by ESIB, Saint-Joseph University of Beirut.

The main purpose of the Master in management of road safety is to contribute to the implementation of the United Nations "World Program for the Decade of Action for Road Safety 2021-2030" and the FIA Mission for 2030. These initiatives target in particular the Gulf States, the Middle East and North Africa Region, where the need to improve road safety is urgent. The Master degree aims to train and support Arab professionals, who will be able to respond to the pressing needs for the improvement of Road Safety and help their states to apply the five pillars of road safety in their respective countries. Henceforth national competencies in the Management of Road Safety are key factor in the struggle for road safety and in lowering the rates of mortality and injury on the roads.

Graduates from the Gulf States, the Middle East and North Africa Region, with a bachelor degree in engineering are eligible.

The master's program is delivered over two semesters from September 2025 to July 2026. Foreign students are required to be physically present in Beirut on a full-time basis for the first four months, starting September 2025 till the end of December 2025, with the option of returning to their home country for the second semester.

The Master curriculum consists of multidisciplinary courses, research reports, practical application, writing a master's thesis and extra circular activities such as field trips, training... The study languages are Arabic and English. After the defense of the thesis, the students will obtain a Master degree in Management of Road Safety. For students wishing to continue their higher education, this Master allows pursuing a doctoral thesis.
