ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- An understanding of the English language.
- A Bachelor degree.
- A completed six months to 5 years professional occupation in humanitarian or development sector, (including internships).

ADMISSION DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

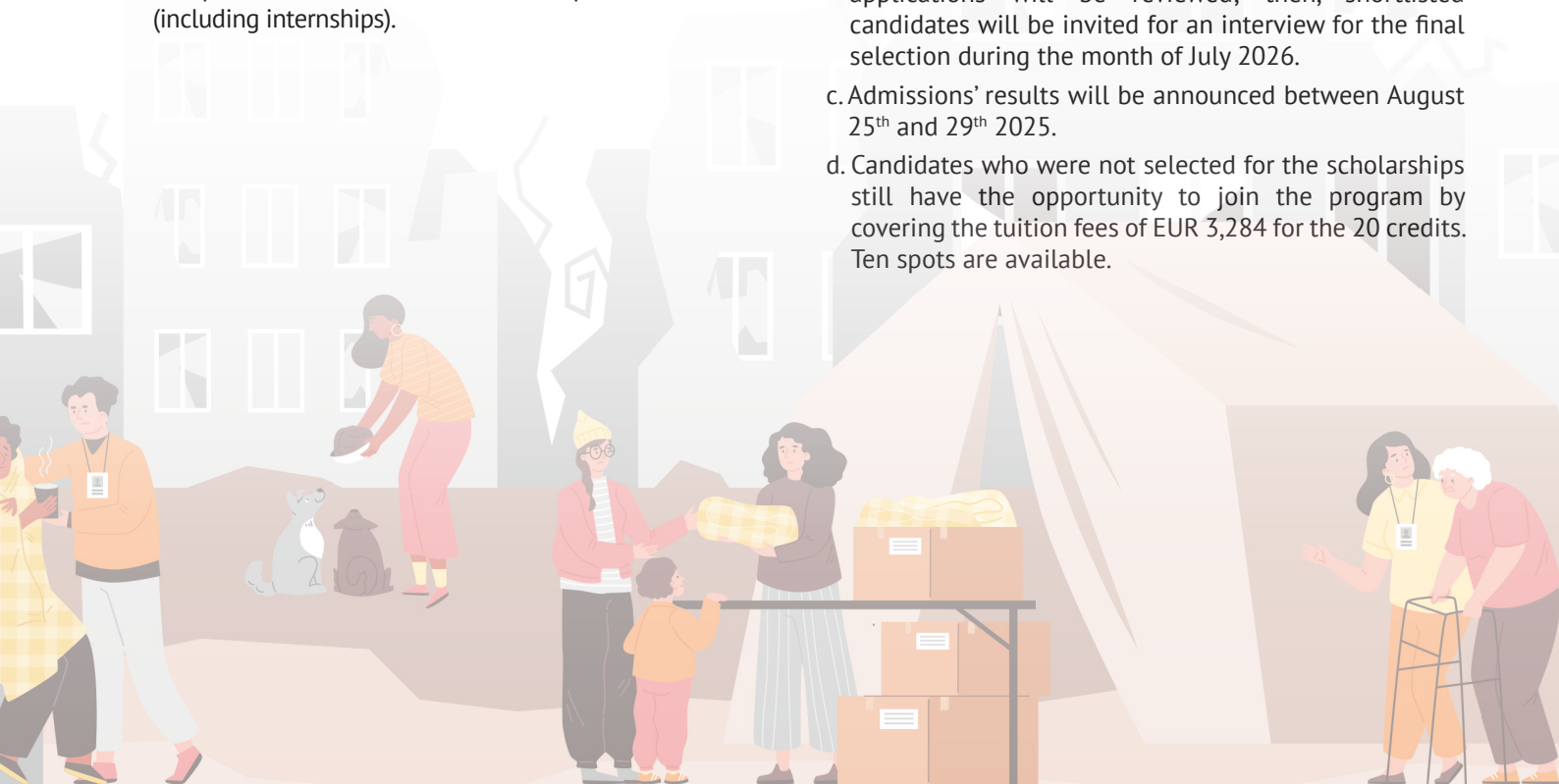
- 1- A passport-sized photo

- 3- A copy of the Lebanese Baccalaureate certificate or its equivalence, certified by the Lebanese Ministry of Education and Higher Education.
- 4- Authenticated copy of the bachelor degree (by the awarding university only).
- 5- Curriculum vitae.
- 6- Motivation letter.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND REGISTRATION

- The Department of International Cooperation of Monaco is granting a full scholarship to 20 students, upon study of each candidate and an online interview with both ELFS and Bioforce.
- The selection process includes two steps: first, all applications will be reviewed; then, shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview for the final selection during the month of July 2026.
- Admissions' results will be announced between August 25th and 29th 2025.
- Candidates who were not selected for the scholarships still have the opportunity to join the program by covering the tuition fees of EUR 3,284 for the 20 credits. Ten spots are available.
