Program Structure

- Duration: Two academic semesters (October 2025 to May 2026)
- Credits: 20 credits, some of which may be counted toward ELFS and ISP Master's programs
- C Language of instruction: English
- C Teaching format: Hybrid

- □ Schedule: Mondays and Wednesdays, from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m.
- Diploma requirement: A final in-depth project aligned with the student's interests, written in the language of their choice (English, French, or Arabic). Projects will be collectively presented during a study day.
