The competition is open to **all high school students in 11th and 12th grades,** regardless of their specialty. Projects can be written in English or French. Students can present individually, in pairs, or in groups of up to three people.

Beach school can submit multiple projects to increase their chances of being among the finalists.

The project must be submitted in Word format and be 5 pages long.

Selection criteria S

Projects will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Originality of the problem addressed;
- ✓ Relevance of the arguments;
- ✓ Analytical skills and critical thinking;
- Relevance of suggested solutions and policies;
- ✓ Clarity and consistency of writing.

In addition, for the finalist projects, there is an evaluation of their oral presentation taking into account clarity, fluidity, power of persuasion and the use of digital media.

All projects submitted must be original work; any plagiarism or use of artificial intelligence to generate content will be disqualifying.
