- Note the below specific to your school:
 - RACL: We advise to take no more than 12-15 US credits per semester. You can take a maximum of 18 US credits. At RACL you will receive your timetable prior to arrival. This is due to the US structure of the programme.
 - EBSL/RBSL, RSDFM, RSFD, RSPP: We advise to take no more than 20 or 25 ECTS per semester. You may have to take 30 ECTS which is a full work load. We are unable to confirm which modules you will be able to take until your arrival at Regent's during the Orientation period.
- Some courses have pre-requisites. By submitting this form you confirm that you have informed yourself about the content of each course selected and that you meet the pre-requisites and that you know about the credit transfer to your home institution.
