- Acceptance letters will be mailed by MARCH 31, 2015.
- The students must arrive during a preset timeframe in Dulles International Airport (IAD) on JUNE
 20, 2015. Please contact our office before making any flight arrangements.
- The program begins on JUNE 22, 2015 and ends on AUGUST 3, 2015.
