Cardiff School of Health Sciences

The Cardiff Met International Summer School is an exciting opportunity for you to study in a vibrant European capital city, with an opportunity for you to embrace British culture and to connect with students from around the world.

Cardiff Met is based over two campuses and five Academic Schools. The International Summer School features a variety of pathways from each of the five Schools.

Improving Public Health

Public health is a global issue that is affected by a range of factors that can be positively influenced by a range of professions. This module will introduce public health in a general sense before drawing on the experience of a range of programmes from across the School of Health Sciences to demonstrate the contribution that different specialities can have. This will include the role of diet, housing and the environment, exercise, and the overarching importance of promoting behavioural change.

Leading Edge Insights into Business, **Leadership and Management**

Cardiff School of Management's sessions will give you insights into areas of knowledge critical to success as a leader and a manager. You will be introduced to areas such as finance, the digital economy, strategic marketing, project management, supply chain and logistics, as have an opportunity to explore your own leadership preferences and strengths.

You will develop your capacity to see 'the big picture' - future leaders of high performing organisations must be able to place their roles within the context of the change occurring in the external environment - as well as appreciate the need for detailed planning. A clear objective of these sessions is to equip participants with the ability to manage and lead within an environment that is constantly changing and in which the only certainty is uncertainty.

Architectural technology and construction in the UK

Get a first-hand overview of the role of an architectural technologist. You will learn about delivering the technical designs and architectural detailing of a range of contemporary building types in the UK. The programme will involve a mix of presentations on the theoretical aspects of modern construction practice in the UK, workshops on architectural detailing, building performance and environmental analysis and visits to construction sites to experience first-hand different building

Summer of Making... Design, make, craft, innovate, experiment, break, remake Spend time with us exploring a range of materials, skills and technologies. The summer programme is ideal for those interested in learning new making, technology and craft skills, from beginner through to advanced practitioner level. Whether you have a keen interest in craft and design, want to develop your skills for

your business or because you are thinking about Further Education/Higher Education, this programme allows you the hands-on practical opportunities to develop work and ideas that meets these needs. Leadership, Literature and Language sessions

English literature and Creative Writing

Taught by published writers and researchers, this course is aimed to support you develop critical and creative writing skills, particularly in the field of fiction. You will explore literature and landscape, fantasy literature, the short story, novel writing, script writing and writing the city.

Leadership and Management in Education

This module is divided into three parts:
The first part is aimed at aspiring leaders in all phases and sectors of education.
You will examine key theories of leadership and how they apply to educational contexts.
School improvement - learn about international research on creating a self-improving school system and provide guidance on using self-assessment and reflective evaluation to identify specific development issues in your profession.
Mentoring and Coaching: Principles and Policies in Action - you will discover and examine the role of mentoring and coaching in leading organisational change.

Cardiff School of Sport

Teachers of English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL)

Uncover the fundamental theoretical and professional aspects of Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages at Master's level. During this module we will examine key issues in the field including teaching methods in English Language Teaching, English for Specific Purposes, including English for Academic Purposes and Teaching English to Young Learners.

International Sport Management

Want to learn, understand and experience more about Sports Management? Interested in academic study in Sports Management? Want to find out more about Sport Management in an international context?

The International Sport Management programme will provide the knowledge on how to manage organisations that deliver sporting competitions, major events, and community programmes that encourage economic activity, social benefits and individual enjoyment in sport.

This module offers a fun, activity based learning experience that provides the best that the University campus and city has to offer. Students will be able to acquire knowledge and understanding of sport management and see examples of organisations delivering a wide-range of sports and physical activities during their stay.

Science of Sports Performance

Want to learn, understand and experience more about the Science of Sports Performance? Interested in academic study of Sports Science? Want to find out more about Sport Science in an international context?

You will find out more about Sport Science and how sports scientists use their knowledge of the human body, the way it moves and the way people think about physical activity, to help you improve your sporting performance and general health.

If you are interested in sport and human physical development, the activities will help you develop a scientific and analytical approach to improving performance. The activities will focus on developing applied scientific knowledge to different aspects of performance such as the development of cardio-vascular fitness, how to improve strength & conditioning, principles of skill development and the psycho-social dimensions of performance.




