

## Summer School Budget 2017

### ❖ Lodging (according to availability)

#### ❖ Résidence la Marne:

285€ (per person for an apartment for two)  
350€ (per person for a studio -1 person apartment)  
*Subject to change*

**Located right behind the school (1 minute walk)**

**+ Optional cleaning service (at the end of your stay):** 65€ for a studio and 100€ for the apartment for two.

**Some studios and some Apartments for 2 people are partly furnished:**

- 2 Beds
- Table
- Mini-stove
- Fridge
- Desk and chairs
- Sheets, Pillows, Blankets



**You will need to bring your own towels.**

**The cost of the housing is payable directly to the residence (cash only) upon your arrival.**

**+ Optional Internet access\*: 19.99€ per month**

\*Please note that the residence la Marne only offers a limited data WiFi connection. If fast internet is important to you (for videos, Skype, etc.), you might want to book an individual internet package in your home country or buy an alternative internet service once in France. The international office will provide you with alternatives in Strasbourg upon request.

## ❖ Meals



- Breakfasts at the main campus: approximately 2,50€ x 20 days (50€)
- Other breakfasts: at your own discretion: maximum 5€ x 8 days (40€)
- Lunches at the main campus: approximately 5€ x 20 days (100€)
- Other lunches: at your own discretion 6-10€ x 10 days (100€)
- Dinners: at your own discretion 5€-20€ x 25 days (mid-range 350€)

Total (high scale) for meals: ≈ **640€**

\* These quotes are based on the assumption that students are eating out. Groceries will come out to less, about ≈**200€ to ≈300€ for lunch and dinner.**

## ❖ Transportation
