

# **Erasmus+ mobility scholarships for USJ students and staff members**

Erasmus+ partnerships allow USJ staff members to benefit from a one week mobility scholarship for teaching or training and it allows USJ's students to benefit from a mobility of one semester. The scholarship covers:

- > The flight ticket (up to a certain amount of money determined by each partner university).
- > The per diem for the staff members and a monthly allowance for students.

Below is a detailed list of USJ's newest Erasmus+ mobility scholarship opportunities for staff members and students for the upcoming spring semester 2018 or academic year 2018/19.

# **University of Minho in Braga, Portugal**

The approved mobility flows are to be shared among 3 partners in Lebanon, including USJ - the principle of best candidates' selection will be applied as well as a balanced distribution among partners — and are the following:

Student Mobility	2 students (5 months)	Subsistence allowance: 800€/month/grantholder Travel: up to 530€/mobility
Teaching Staff	1 (5 working days + 2 travel days)	Subsistence allowance: 840€/grantholder Travel: up to 530€/mobility

# Masarykova univerzita | Masaryk University, Czech Republic

USJ can send 2 students (all cycles) and 1 teaching staff during the next semester and next academic year.

## Tampere University of Applied Sciences, TAMK, Finland

Agreement specific only for IESAV - Institut d'études scéniques audiovisuelles et cinématographiques students/staff members

- > Students: There is a grant for 2 students for 5 months during the upcoming spring semester 2018.
- > Staff: There are grants for 2 teachers.

# Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece

# Università Telematica Internazionale UNINETTUNO, Italy

# Università degli Studi di Torino, Italy

## Agreement specific only for ISP - Institut des Sciences Politiques students/staff members

- > Students: 3 Master students for a mobility of 6 months each during the spring semester 2018 at the Culture, Politics and Society Department of the University of Turin for the academic year 2017/2018.
  - The financial support from Erasmus+ EU funds for the mobility period is EUR 850 per month. In addition, the participant shall receive EUR 320 as a contribution for travel.
- > Staff: One teaching staff mobility for 1 week (8 hours of teaching).

#### **Application procedure:**

- > Students: Fill and sign USJ's <u>outgoing mobility form</u> and hand it to USJ's international relations office.
  - Deadline to apply for the next semester is OCTOBER 15<sup>th</sup>

## Free University of Berlin, Germany

#### **Grants:**

- Fixed Contribution to travel costs: 360 €
- ➤ Monthly grant incoming students (USJ to FUB): 800 €
- ➤ Daily allowance incoming staff (USJ to FUB): 120 €
  - 1. Mobilities for spring semester 2018 (mobilities should be done before July 31, 2018)
    Available grants for 1 student (in any level) for 4 months (spring semester 2018) and 2 staff members for 7 days each.

### **Application procedure:**

- > Students: check <u>FACT SHEET</u> for all details and procedure. Fill and sign USJ's <u>outgoing</u> <u>mobility form</u> and hand it along with other required documents to USJ's international relations office.
  - o Deadline to apply for the next semester is OCTOBER 15<sup>th</sup>
  - → PhD students could come from February to July 2018 (6 months). They can check how to find a supervisor here.
- > Staff:
- ❖ Teaching staff: Send an email to <u>sri.mobilite@usj.edu.lb</u> with your CV in English and a short paragraph explaining your background and interests (in which field of study would you be interested to teach/the dates in which you would like to go/the courses you already teach etc.). Also fill and send the <u>mobility agreement</u>.
  - Teaching Staff can come anytime during the semester (not in semester break), no nomination deadline. Teaching requirement: 8 hours per week.
- Training Staff: administrative staff for the Erasmus+ Staff Training Week (25-29/06/2018) there will most probably be 3-4 programs out of the following
  - o Career Service
  - o Libraries
  - Continuing Education

# 2. Mobilities for academic year 2018/2019 (mobilities should be done before July 31, 2019)

Available grants for 1 student (in any level) for 5 months and 2 staff members for 7 days each.

#### Notes:


- Same procedure as above
- Nomination deadline for winter Semester 18/19 (October to February, 5 months) is May 2018.
- Nomination deadline for summer Semester 19 (April to July, 4 months) is December 2018.
- PhD students can come for 6 months (October to March, April to September)
- Teaching Staff can come anytime during the semester (not in semester break), no nomination deadline. Teaching requirement: 8 hours per week.
- Erasmus+ Staff Training Week will most probably be during the last week of June, 2019.

## **Université de Namur, Belgium**

Available grants for 2 students for next academic year (1 for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester and 1 for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester)

### **Application procedure:**

Fill and sign USJ's <u>outgoing mobility form</u> and hand it to USJ's international relations office. Deadline to apply for the next academic year is May 15<sup>th</sup>.
