

# Impact Evaluation – Teacher Coaching Intervention

## Information for enumerators

**Background:** The Government of Lebanon in partnership with the World Bank and New York University are conducting an impact evaluation of a new teacher coaching intervention in Lebanese public schools in Grades 4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>. The impact evaluation will require data collection efforts, and we are seeking your institution's interest in partnering with us to identify suitable students interested in becoming enumerators during the data collection this fall.

**Scope:** Students will be trained for a full 6-day training. Then they will visit schools covering all governorates in Lebanon. In schools, students will administer tools such as teacher and student surveys and classroom observation tools, as well as conduct interviews with teachers and coaches about their work in the classroom. Students would be moderately compensated for their time and for transportation costs. In addition to this, you may be interested in considering offering academic credit from your institution to participating students in this activity, as it will require the acquisition and application of technical skills and knowledge.

**Enumerator Profile:** University students (undergraduate and graduate) from the disciplines of education, social science, public policy or administration, or others in related fields with an interest in education. Having experience in data collection efforts would be preferred but is not required.

We aim to recruit approximately 60 individuals. Although we will seek to include most of the individuals recruited, students will only be allowed to become enumerators for the data collection if they are able to successfully complete the full 6-day training and to pass the reliability assessment.

### **Time Commitment:**

The training of enumerators will take place from Monday, October 21, 2019 till Saturday, October 26, 2019 for 6 full days (9am till 6pm). Baseline data collection in schools will occur from October 28, 2019 till November 22, 2019. Data collection in schools will be from 8am till 2pm.

Interested candidates will need to commit to fully attend the 6-day training from October 21 till October 26, as well as commit to be available for at least 10 days of data collection during the data collection period.
