In 2012, Saint-Joseph University of Beirut have launched the Master in Management of Road Safety. Recognized by the Ministry of Education and Higher Education in Lebanon, this Master is delivered by ESIB, Saint-Joseph University of Beirut.

The main purpose of the Master in management of road safety is to contribute to the implementation of the United Nations "World Program for the Decade of Action for Road Safety 2011-2020" and the FIA Mission for 2030. These initiatives target in particularly the Gulf States, the Middle East and North Africa Region, where the need to improve road safety is urgent. The Master degree aims to train and support Arab professionals, who will be able to respond to the pressing needs for the improvement of Road Safety and help their states to apply the five pillars of road safety in their respective countries. Henceforth national competencies in the Management of Road Safety are key factor in the struggle for road safety and in lowering the rates of mortality and injury on the roads.

Graduates from Lebanon, with four years of University Studies, including a first cycle university degree, in various university disciplines, (engineering, social and human sciences and related disciplines) are eligible.

The Master curriculum consists of multidisciplinary courses, research reports, practical application, writing a master's thesis and extra circular activities such as field trips, training... The study languages are Arabic and English.

After the defense of the thesis, the students will obtain a Master degree in Management of Road Safety. **The graduation ceremony will take place in June 2021**. For students wishing to continue their higher education, this Master allows pursuing a doctoral thesis.

Saint-Joseph University and other sponsors offer scholarships to Lebanese students. The scholarship for the academic year includes:

- Tuition fees (18 200 US \$ Eighteen thousand two hundred US dollars)
- Financial support (a total amount of 500 000 LL per month, for 10 months)
- Internship trip for approximatively 10 days, if conditions allow.
