The University has been listening to you to help you on your way since you first met our orientation specialists at the Student Information and Orientation Office (SIO). ADMISSION FOR BACHELOR'S DEGREES

1. How

To apply for a Bachelor's degree at USJ, the candidate can submit an application during three admission periods: **Early, Regular** and **Late**.

Since English is the main language of study in these programs, the candidate should pass **the English Aptitude Test** organized by USJ or have the following equivalent TOEFL and IELTS scores:

Level A:

Internet-based TOEFL: 80 Paper-based TOEFL: 548

Level B:

Internet-Based TOEFL: 60-78 Paper-Based TOEFL: 498-546 or IELTS: 6.5

Applications can be submitted on weekdays between 10a.m. and 3:30p.m.* during the following periods:

Early | October 17 until December 22, 2022



Regular | February 6 until June 19, 2023



Late | June 20 until August 21, 2023

The USJ Student Dormitory is located on Damascus Road, Beirut.


